Outline of Activities and Suggested Attire

<p>6/22 FRIDAY (Orientation) Casual</p>	<p>This is arrival day and acclimation. No specific attire required.</p>
<p>6/23 SATURDAY (Seoul tour/Angel's Haven/Han River cruise) Group t-shirts</p>	<p>This day, the tour t-shirt is mandatory as we will be taking group pictures. Please wear a comfortable/casual bottom and comfortable shoes. We will be transported by the tour bus, but we will be doing a fair amount of walking as well as playing with the children from Angel's Haven. We will take the children on the Han River cruise, which can be chilly, so you should bring a warm jacket and leave it on the bus during the day.</p>
<p>6/24 SUNDAY (Church/Host Family) Business casual</p>	<p>If you are attending, business casual clothes are encouraged for the church service. After church, you will meet your host family. You will have the opportunity to talk to your host family about what you will do in advance and you should dress accordingly and/or bring a change of clothes (typical activities are dinner/cooking at their home, shopping and touring, or hiking). If you wear high heels for church, it is recommended that you bring a change of shoes as you may be walking with your host families.</p>
<p>6/25 MONDAY (Adoption Agency) Business casual Casual</p>	<p>When you go to your agencies, business casual attire is recommended. After the visit, we will return to the hotel and you will have the opportunity to change if you would like. In the afternoon, we will have a group session with a guest speaker (at the hotel) and you can dress casually for this. We will also go on a hike after dinner.</p>
<p>6/26 Tuesday (Paju tour) Casual</p>	<p>We will ride the bus to Paju and do some touring at the DMZ and surrounding area. You will walk a lot. Wear comfortable shoes and clothes.</p>
<p>6/27 WEDNESDAY (Police Academy) Business casual Casual Waterproof shoes</p>	<p>We will leave early and ride the bus for two hours to the police academy. You should dress business casual for the police academy visit. After the visit, you will have the opportunity to change if you would like into a casual outfit for the second bus ride, which will also be approximately two hours. Before checking into the hotel, we will visit a fish market, where you will want shoes that can get wet and won't be ruined.</p>
<p>6/28 THURSDAY (School, bus ride) Professional/ Business casual Casual</p>	<p>You will be a guest teacher at Posco Jigok Elementary School. For this day, you must wear professional/business casual attire. In specific, no shorts, jeans, or flip flops are allowed. Big tattoos should be covered. After the class, you will have the opportunity to change clothes before departing for your meaningful place. Most people will ride the bus back to Seoul (4 hours) or go with staff to their individual destination.</p>
<p>6/29 FRIDAY (Meaningful places) Casual Business Casual</p>	<p>If you are visiting your orphanage, a government office, or police station, we recommend you wear business casual attire and cover big tattoos. If you are touring, you can wear casual clothes.</p>
<p>6/30 SATURDAY (Buddhist temple, banquet) Casual Business casual/semi-formal</p>	<p>In the morning, we will walk from the hotel to the Jo Ge Sa Buddhist Temple. You should wear comfortable clothes and shoes for this visit. After the temple, you can visit the nearby market for shopping or enjoy a few free hours. You should return to the hotel by 4 pm to prepare for the banquet, for which you should wear business casual/semi-formal clothing.</p>
<p>7/1 SUNDAY Casual</p>	<p>This is the departure day. No specific attire required.</p>
